## Bodywork for Horses & Their Humans

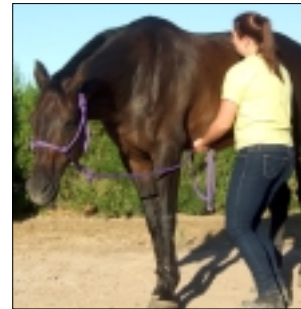
### April 11-15, 2011
